Personal Property Tax Questions

Q: Why am I being taxed for a vehicle that I no longer own?

Assessor's Phone: 868-4101

A: Your tax is based on the vehicles you owned on January 1st of the tax year. Even if you no longer own the vehicles, you still pay tax based on what you owned the first day of the year.

Contact Assessor's Office if:

Q: Why is my bill so high?

-You suspect your tax amount is incorrect.

A: The amount of tax you owe each year is based on the value of your vehicles, which is established by the County Assessor using a standard rate book. The assessed value of your vehicles can be found at the bottom of your statement.

-You have questions about assessed value.

Q: I am no longer a Missouri resident, do I still owe this tax?

-Vehicle information is incorrect.

A: Yes, according to state law, your tax obligation is established on January 1st. Even if you move to a different state on January 2nd, you still owe the tax for the year. Unfortunately, the law has no provisions for prorating the tax due.

-There is incorrect information on your bill.

Q: What if my loan company is supposed to pay my bill?

A: If your loan company is supposed to pay your taxes, please don't get anxious and pay the bill yourself. Doing so will result in two payments. Your loan company will contact us directly for a duplicate bill. You need not take any action.
